It was started by Mahadeo Havaji Bachche, who, along with a few other delivery men saw an opportunity to deliver home-cooked meals to office workers. Over the years, the enterprise has grown into a well-organized operation, though it has retained its traditional methods.

Their system is renowned for its precision and reliability, handling thousands of meals daily with minimal technology. The dabbawalas use a complex coding system involving color-coded tags and symbols to ensure each meal reaches its correct destination.

Despite the simplicity of their operations, they boast an impressive accuracy rate and have become a symbol of effective grassroots business practices and urban efficiency.

Meals are prepared at home and placed in metal tiffin carriers (dabbas). Each dabba is marked with a unique code that includes details about the sender and the recipient's location.

The dabbas are collected from homes in the morning and transported by a network of dabbawalas. They use various modes of transport, including bicycles, trains.

The dabbawalas use a unique coding system combining colors, numbers, and symbols to ensure accurate delivery. This system is simple yet highly effective, enabling them to deliver around 200,000 meals daily with a very low error rate.

The dabbawala organization is composed of a cooperative of workers who are typically from the same community and share a sense of responsibility and trust. This community-based structure helps in maintaining high levels of reliability and accountability.

New dabbawalas undergo rigorous training to understand the coding system and the logistics of the operation.
